Dear Mr Ghandar

I am pleased to advise that you have been registered in this State under Division 1 of Part IV of the Marriage Act 1961 as a Minister of Religion, resident in New South Wales, authorised to solemnize marriages at any place in Australia.

Please note that your registration number is [REDACTED]

All marriages solemnized in Australia must comply with the provisions of the Marriage Act 1961. As an authorised celebrant who is a Minister of a recognised denomination you may only use a form of ceremony acceptable to the denomination by which you have been nominated. Reference to this ceremony must be clearly shown on the official Marriage Certificate.

If there should be any change to your name, address or designation of if you should cease to exercise the functions of a Minister of Religion of the denomination by which you were nominated for registration or in respect of which you are now registered, you are required to notify your Nominating Authority of these facts within 30 days.

Please note that your registration number must be clearly shown in any correspondence and in the bottom right corner of each official marriage certificate.
