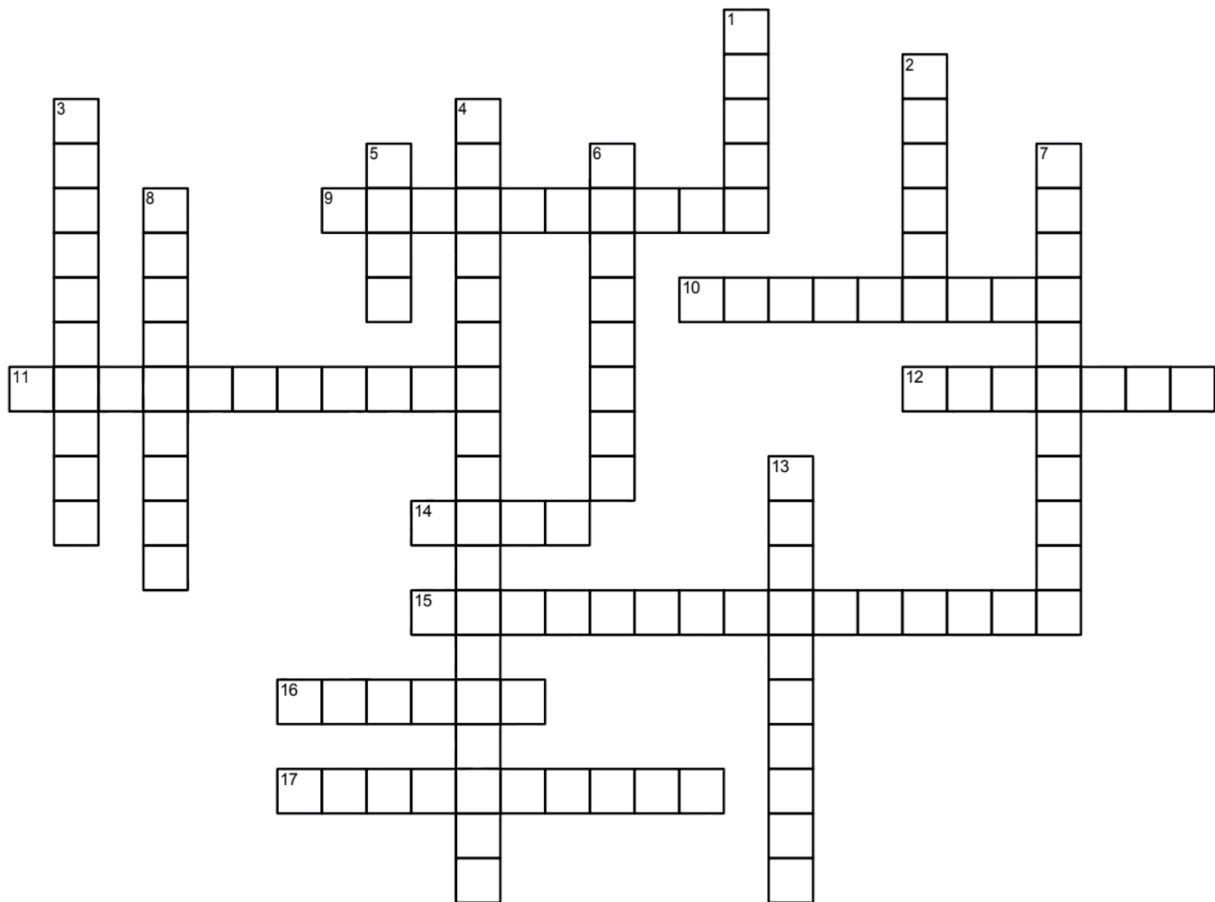


Soilsafe Kids Crossword 1

Down:

- 1: Part of a plant that has a rough texture and can't be broken up

- 6: A reddish-brown worm that only uses a tunnel once and eats poop
