Topic

Write about a building or architectural site, of any size or scale. Why does it have significance to you?

Word Length

Open: up to 1500
Secondary School: up to 800

Entry Criteria

An essay must address the set topic, must be wholly the work of the person submitting it, and must not have been published previously.

Prizes

Open category winner: \$2000
Secondary School category winner: \$1000
Highly Commended: \$500*
*up to three Highly Commended Awards will be made
