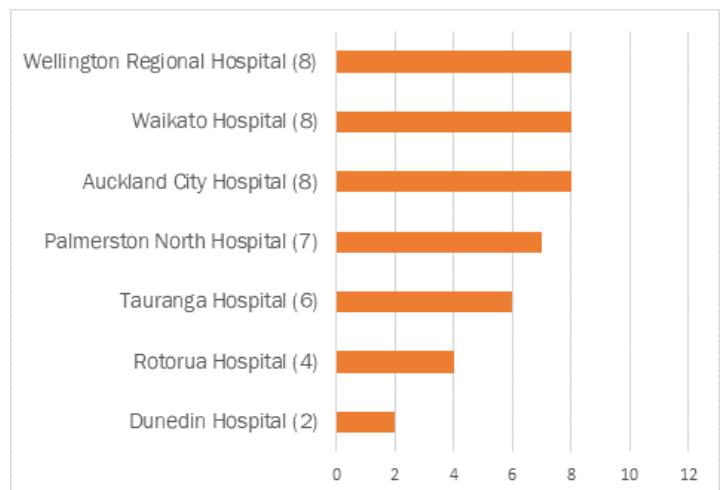
Participating sites

PantoCIN opened to recruited in 29 May 2019

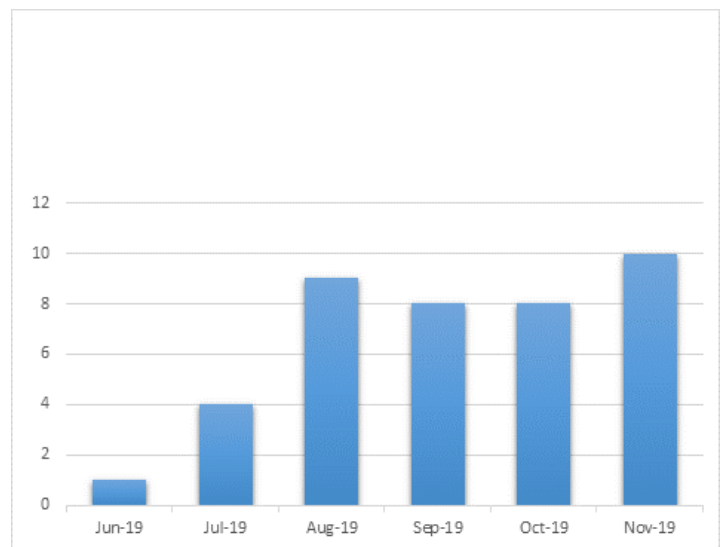
Currently, nine sites are participating, with two further sites expected to open to recruitment

Focus on GCP

GCP training is recommended every 2-3 years for delivery research staff

Free online GCP training can be accessed here:

Some tips to ensure PantoCIN is GCP compliant at your site:

1. **Evidence new staff training** using the training log. Update records: delegation log, CV and GCP
2. Ensure a clear documentation of processes related to **primary endpoint data**. For this study this is the collection of data via participant questionnaires
3. Report **all AEs** up to the start of cycle 3. SAE reporting continues until 28 days after final study treatment

Patient Reported Outcomes

For patients who complete **paper** questionnaires

Please discuss with patient / write down the expected date for day five

For patients who use the **app**

Ensure the notifications setting is sent to 'on' for the app

For patients who use the **website**

We have put an amendment to allow us to email the weblink, as part of the reminder. Please ensure the patient has bookmarked or recorded the website link

For **all patients**, please inform the patient that, when they can expect to complete the questionnaires and that they are recording their symptoms from **24 hrs after chemotherapy to day 5**. If questionnaires are inaccessible, for any reason, then they can be completed on the phone with site staff
