

Graeme Hanson AsBIC Early Career Researcher Award

The Graeme Hanson AsBIC Early Career Researcher Award provides support and recognition to scientists in the Asia-Pacific Region at the beginning of their careers. The support of early career researchers was at the heart of Graeme Hanson's work throughout his career. The awards will be made for excellence in the broad field of biological inorganic chemistry covering, but not limited to, Metalloproteins - Structure and Function, Metals in Medicine, Metal Ion Transport and Homeostasis, Metals in Physiology and Disease, Molecular Imaging - Multiple Modalities, Environmental Biological Inorganic Chemistry and Spectroscopy and Computational Chemistry.

Every second year, there will be made up to two awards available. The Awardees will be presented with a cash award, a certificate and a citation describing their research career for which the award has been made. The Awardees will be invited to present their latest research results in the award lectures at the next AsBIC conference.

Eligibility

Members of the Society of Biological Inorganic Chemistry (SBIC) from the Asia-Pacific region, who have been awarded a PhD degree not more than 8 years before the start of the AsBIC conference will be eligible to apply for a Graeme Hanson AsBIC Early Career Researcher Award. Career interruptions will be taken into consideration. The following types of interruption will be considered:

- carer's responsibility;
- disruption due to international relocation for post-doctoral studies or other research employment not exceeding 3 months per international relocation;
- illness;
- maternity or parental leave; and/or
- unemployment, or non-research employment.)

Applications for the Graeme Hanson AsBIC Early Career Researcher Award need to include:

- application form
- curriculum vitae including a list of publications and the names of three referees, who may be consulted by the Selection Committee,
- A 300-word citation
- An abstract of your award lecture

A call for applications will be published mid year before the upcoming AsBIC conference

Notes for the Graeme Hanson Early Career Researcher Award 2020

1. The Selection Committee will be nominated by the local organizing committee of the AsBIC conference.
2. Awards will be only be made if the awardees give an oral presentation at the upcoming AsBIC conference.
3. We are looking to reward and promote excellence considering the standards in the different sub-disciplines of biological inorganic chemistry.
4. The Selection Committee reserves the right to make no award.
5. The decision of the panel is final and no appeal will be entertained.
