FISH EXPERT PANEL – MINUTES FROM MEETING 2

Welcome and actions from previous meeting. All actions complete or underway.

Report Structure. No significant issues with report structure. Ensure scope boundaries are communicated up front, and include detail on the current state of fisheries. Positive feedback on 'Vision' example (from Plastics report) and agreement to use as template for the project.

Feedback on Data and Knowledge Table. Discussion covered the importance of community science (both in mātauranga Māori and by involving fishers), understanding of productivity and wider scale fisheries, patterns over time, conflicting rights, use of data outside of FNZ process, tertiary funding and data sharing, objectives of funding, success and limitations of current research programmes, cameras and data collection.

Feedback on New Technologies / Research Table. Discussion on modelling, AI, DNA technologies, moving beyond trawling and dredging, monitoring and surveillance / cameras, acoustics, nanotechnology, microplastics, and lasers.

Further meetings. Agreement to two further meetings at the end of June and end of July.
