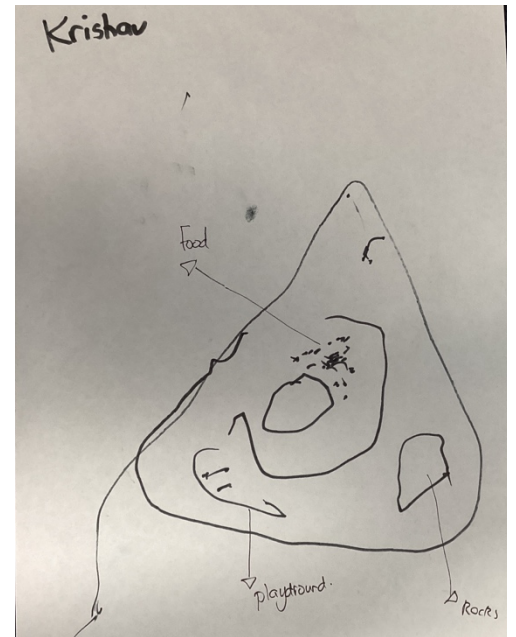
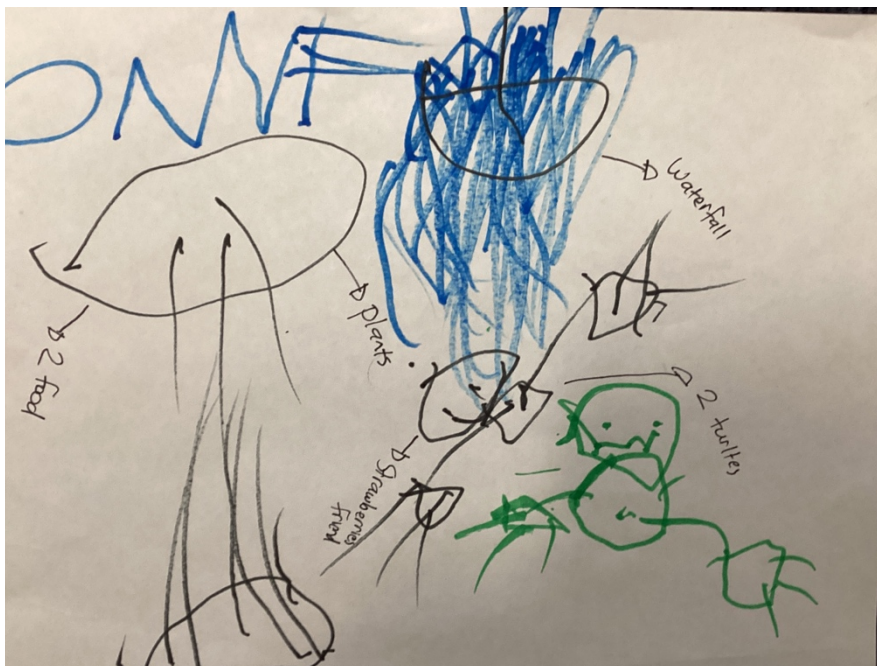
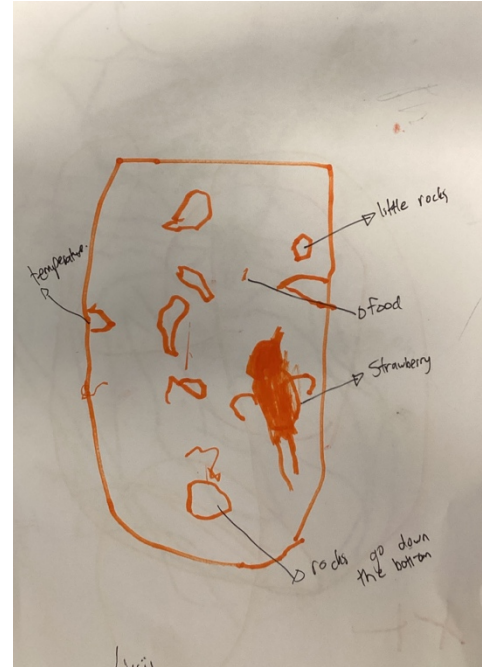
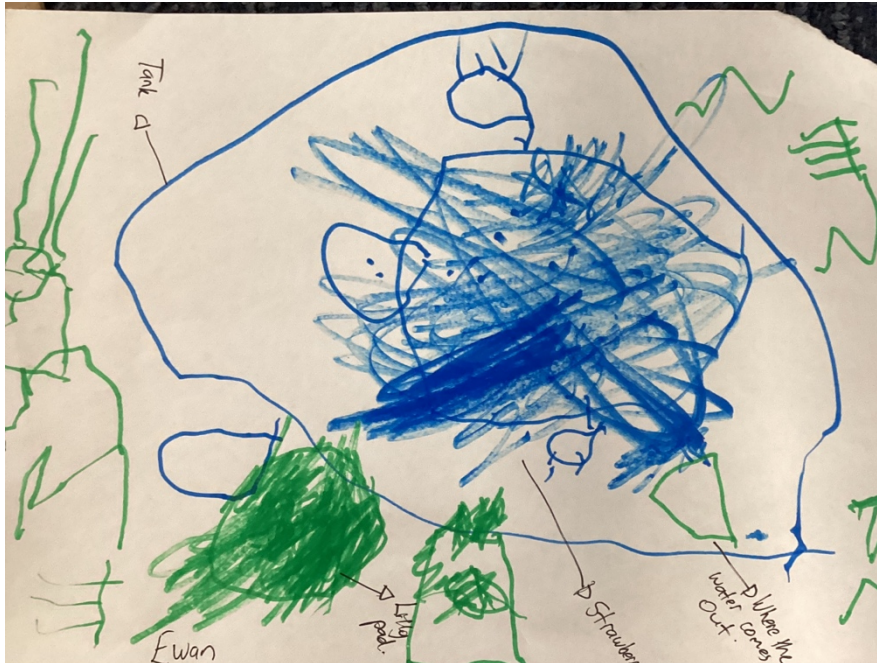
When we picked Strawberry up from the MUDLA, we noticed that she had grown.



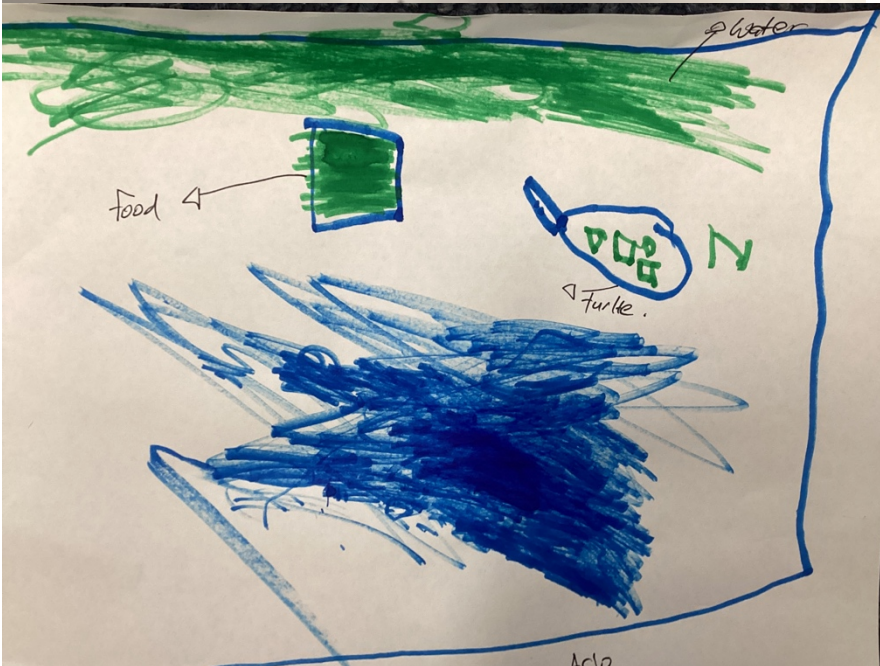
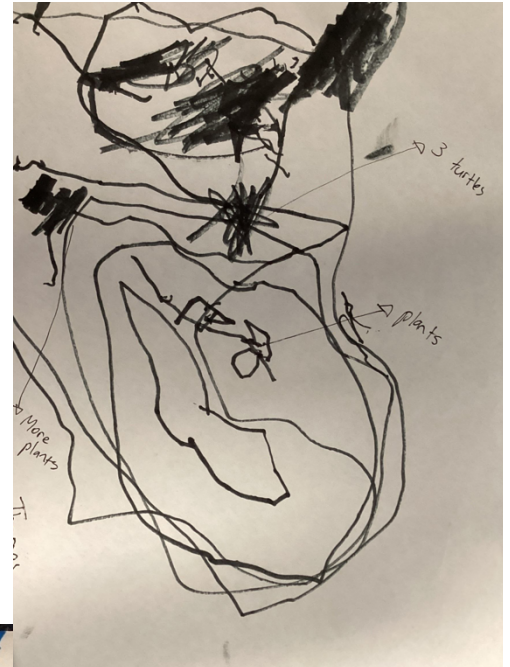
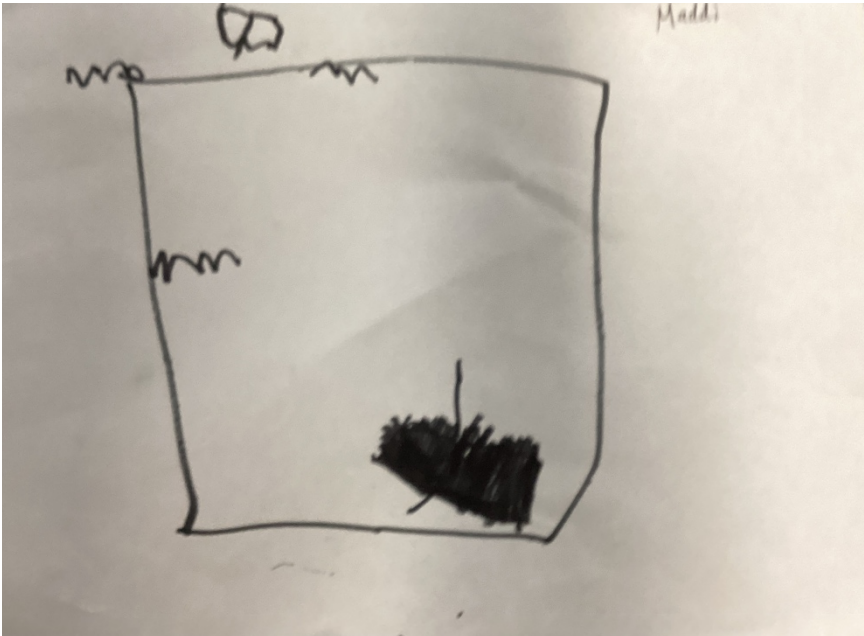
This made us worry that she didn't have enough space in her home, so we decided that we would find her a new home to live in.
