And so that's really important that they get that emphasis that you really care about their child and that you really know about their child and what their child is learning within your classroom. So, take the time to make yourself look really professional on that day. Get yourself a really nice notebook, notepad and be really well prepared coming into these meetings so that you can share with the families the wonderful things that you've been doing within the classroom with their child.
