

TEAL ORAL ASSESSMENT TASK 12: Retelling a folk story

Instructions for students

1. Tell your group or class a folk story or legend from your country. It should be like the story the teacher read to the class.
2. You might like to make some notes to help you remember what you will say:

Name of story and the country it comes from:	
Setting: Where it takes place:	
Main characters: Who is in the story?	
The events: What happens?	
Climax: what is the most important event in the story?	
Resolution: How does the story end? How is the problem solved?	
Moral of the story: What lesson can we learn from the story?	

3. You have five minutes to tell your story to your audience. You may use pictures you have found or drawn to help you to tell the story.
4. Remember as you speak, your story will be more interesting to your listeners if you:
 - look at the audience while you speak,
 - speak with a loud voice (but don't shout!),
 - stress the important parts,
 - say the words characters speak like you are that character!
