There are unexpected problems that Jack has to face but there are also adventures and lots of humour.

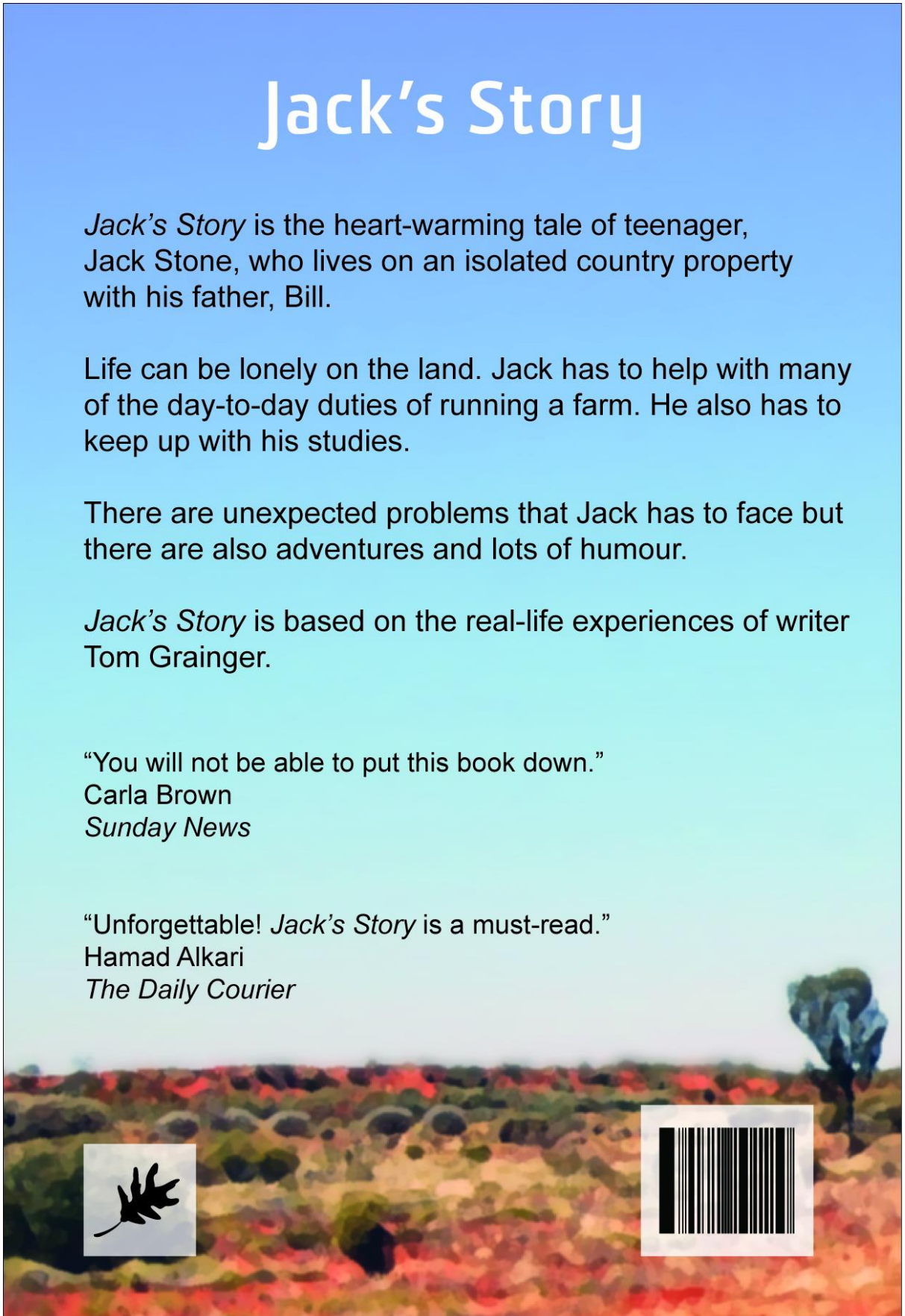
