CURRICULUM BANDS STRUCTURE & ENSEMBLE PATHWAYS YEARS 5/6/7

YEAR 5 CURRICULUM Group: Beginner Instrumentalists (Beginner woodwind, brass and percussion) For: Students who are new to their instruments in 2020 Year 5 Band When: Day 9 Period 4 throughout the year commencing in term 2.

**CO-CURRICULAR ENSEMBLE** 

Group: Concert Band (experienced woodwind, brass and percussion) For: highly experienced Year 5 Practised brass, woodwind and percussion students Students can access entry into Concert Band after consultation with instrumental teacher, parents and Head of Bands. When: Thursday 3.40pm – 4.45pm

YEAR 6

CURRICULUM Group: Continuing Instrumentalists (Beginner woodwind, brass and percussion) For: Students who are continuing on their instruments in 2021 Year 6 Band

When: Day 3 Period 2 throughout the year commencing Wednesday Feb 10.

**CO-CURRICULAR ENSEMBLE** 

Group: Concert Band (experienced woodwind, brass and percussion) For: Experienced Year 6 Practised brass, woodwind and percussion students When: Thursday 3.40pm – 4.45pm Students can access entry into Concert Band after consultation with instrumental teacher, parents and Head of Bands.

## YEAR 7

CURRICULUM Group: Beginner Instrumentalists (Beginner woodwind, brass and percussion) For: students who are new to their instrument in 2020.

#### Apprentice Band

When: Day 8 class 3.35-4.30pm. This class will be held fortnightly commencing Wednesday 17 Feb then every Day 8 thereafter.

Note: Students can progress to Practised Class during the year if referred by Music staff.

#### Group: Practised Band Class (experienced woodwind, brass and percussion) For: Students who have experience on their respective instrument who take lessons. <u>Practised Band</u>

When: Day 3 Period 3. This band class will be held fortnightly commencing Wednesday 10 Feb then every Day 3 thereafter.

### **CO-CURRICULAR ENSEMBLES**

<u>Concert Band</u> For: less experienced Practised brass, woodwind and percussion students When: Every Thursday 3.40pm-4.45pm. Mr Ford will notify the students of their first rehearsal date.

#### Wind Band

For: highly experienced Practised brass, woodwind and percussion students When: Every Thursday 7.20am-8.20am commencing Thursday 4<sup>th</sup> February

## Concert Band – Thursday 3:40pm-4:40pm

Students identified for Concert Band will be drawn from;

- Year 8 Students taking private lessons but NOT already in Wind Band
- Year 7 Practised Class students NOT already in Wind Band
- Year 7 Students taking private lessons on woodwind, brass & percussion
- Year 7 piano students who will play percussion as their core ensemble requirement
- Year 6 Practised Class students taking lessons on woodwind, brass & percussion
- Year 6 Students taking lessons on woodwind, brass & percussion
- Year 5 Experienced Students taking lessons (these students will be invited to attend)
- Any student in Year 6-8 who may be referred by a Music Staff member
- Any private piano students who will play percussion as their core ensemble requirement

**Note:** Throughout the year an injection of students may come into Concert Band from Year 5 Band, Year 6 Band and Year 7 Apprentice Band after consultation with Instrumental staff, Parents, Band Directors and Head of Bands.
