CLOTHING

Beanie	Wool / fleece must be able to pull down over the ears.

1x Pants	track suit pants or sports leggings
4 x Pairs socks	2 x Thick Woollen; 2 x sports socks.

Underwear	A change for each day
Runners	For walking, bike riding etc
Old Spare shoes	Closed toe shoe for caving – may get dirty and wet (e.g. dunlop volleys, old runners)

BEDDING

Sleeping bag	Good quality. MUST have a hood and draw string, we recommend it is rated to at least -2. Pack down no larger than 20L.
Sleeping mat	Air mat, self-inflating or closed cell foam
Pillow (optional)	Very small inflatable travel pillow
Sheet liner (optional)	Protects the sleeping bag and gives extra warmth
