On every program, staff and students are briefed on evacuation procedures. Groups' sked in at 7.30am and 5.30pm. In fire season- Staff and students to carry one full set fire retardant clothes.	Activities can continue as planned Program Coordinator monitoring all weather and fire warnings	As per previous plus: Program coordinator to assess and plan for day, taking into consideration: Distance, time and mode of travel. Student age, fitness and medical issues. Consider long range forecast	As per previous, plus: Assess each groups on individual factors. No fires, flames or cooking stoves to be used outdoors. Keep group within 1 hour from lodge / evacuation point. Additional weather update / sked at 1pm.	As per previous, plus: Relocate groups to safe area with easy vehicle access. Buses on standby for evacuation if required. Maintain regular communication with coordinator.	Relocate to Melbourne, if safe; otherwise relocate to nearest township / safe area. If in transit – return to Melbourne if safe, or to nearest safe town.
