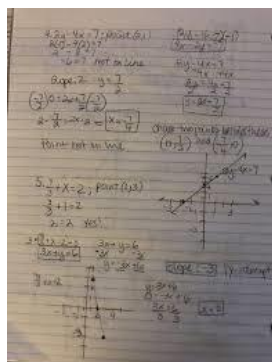


## HOW TO TAKE GOOD PHOTOS OF YOUR SCHOOLWORK

1. Make sure the room is not too bright or too dark
2. Check lights are not shining into the camera or device
3. Try to use a phone camera or an iPad (it's clearer)
4. Try and get the whole page in the one image
5. Limit the amount of background in the photo
6. Try not to wobble the camera
7. Take photo from directly above the work, not on side angle

8. Check to see your writing can be read once you have taken the photo

## HOW TO TAKE GOOD VIDEOS and VOICE RECORDINGS

1. Make sure the room is not too bright or too dark
2. Check lights are not shining into the camera or device
3. Make sure the area is quiet and people know you are filming
4. Try to use a phone camera (it's clearer)
5. Try not to wobble the camera
6. Get permission from other people who are in the video
7. Please listen to the recording before you upload to make sure you can be heard clearly.

**TIP-** parents can upload their phone photos and videos to seesaw
