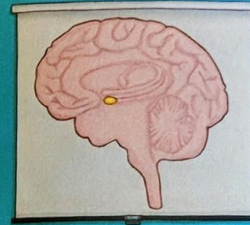


Prefrontal Cortex

The **Prefrontal Cortex** (PFC, for short) is the part of your brain behind your forehead. It lets you make plans and decisions.
